Model of class 310 electric multiple unit driving trailer composite open in British Rail blue and grey livery.

Model locomotive: British Rail Railfreight Class 60 No.60001 'Design Aspiration' concept outline model, 2 3/4" gauge, mounted on track and contained in carrying case. 60001 was later named 'Steadfast'.

Model steam locomotive, Sans Pareil, early 19th century, attributed to Timothy Hackworth but which may have been built by Trevithick or Hackworth.
