

CREATING AN ACCOUNT ON STEM LEARNING

This guide covers creating and maintaining an account on the STEM Learning website, so that you can request support from a STEM Ambassador.

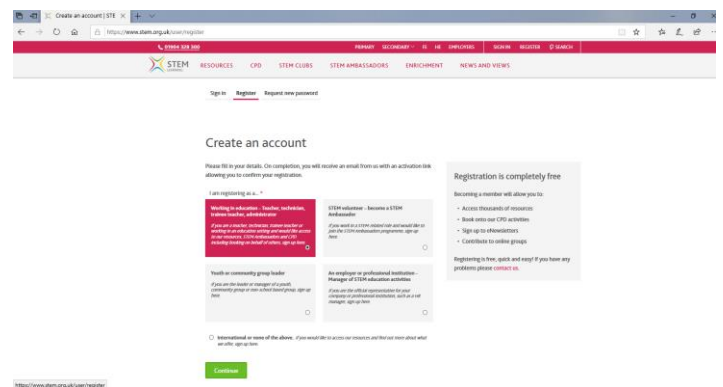
As a quick reminder, STEM Ambassadors:

- Are volunteers
- Come from Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics industry or research
- Are free to use
- Have an enhanced, child workforce DBS and have done safeguarding training

To create your account, you need to visit the STEM Learning website and sign up for a “Working in education” or “Youth or community group leader” account:

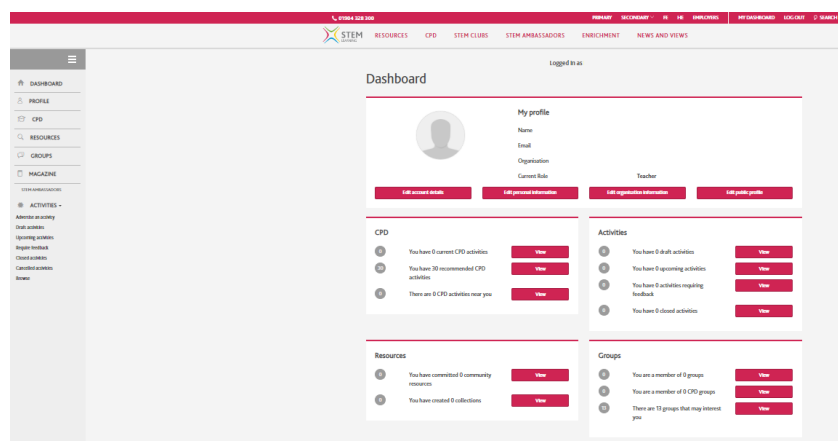

If you think you have a teacher account under an old email address, let us know as we can check that for you.



You can use a work or personal email address. Colleagues at your organisation and ambassadors won't be able to see it.

Once your details are registered, you will receive an email to confirm your sign up. After confirmation, you will be taken to your dashboard, where you can edit your details. It looks something like this:



You'll receive emails from STEM Learning about resources, training and events they have coming up. We also send out a newsletter once per half term with local opportunities. You can unsubscribe from these at any time.
