

## Finding activities

Once you have completed induction and received your DBS certificate, you're ready for volunteering.

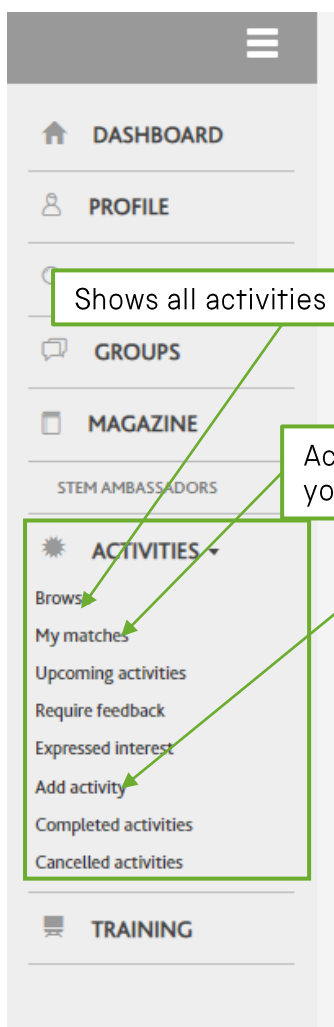
There are all sorts of activities you can do as a STEM Ambassador, but where do you find the opportunities?

You may already have links with a school or community group, perhaps because you have children there. Your place of work may arrange events, host schools or work experience students on site. If you do these types of activities, don't forget to log them!

If you don't have those opportunities, or want to broaden the types of things you're involved in, you can search for activities on the STEM Learning website, or even through the [STEM Ambassador app](#).

### The STEM Learning website

Once you have [signed in to your STEM Learning account](#), click on "Activities" from the left hand side menu.



Selecting "Browse" or "My matches" will come up with a table of Ambassador requests.



Click here and leave a message for the organiser to say what you can offer.

We recommend always leaving a message for the organiser, they will only see your name when you “express interest”. If you can’t make the date or would be happy helping, but not running an activity yourself, say so! Most organisers can be flexible. We like to think of the platform as a conversation tool.

If you’re going ahead with an activity, don’t forget to “accept” any offer from the teacher (they’ll need to press an “offer” button first). This means your volunteering hours are logged and you are insured if the worst happens.

All messages are done through the website and you will get a notification email when you have a new message. Log in and navigate to “Activities” then “Expressed interest” for those you’ve started chats with, or “Upcoming activities” for those you have accepted.
