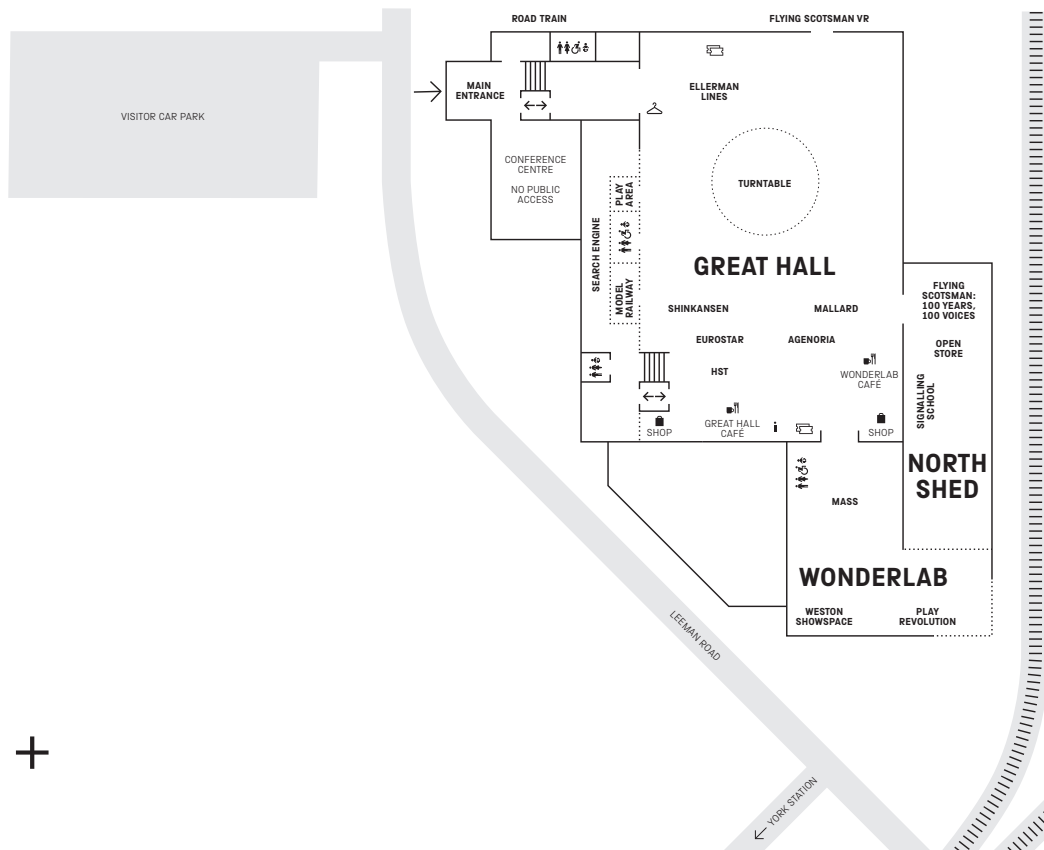

Go on a journey back in time and around the world as you join the greatest moments in the locomotives's past 100 years.

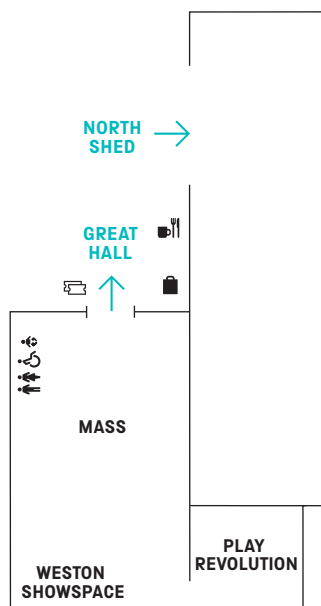


### INDOOR PLAY AREA

### GREAT MACHINE

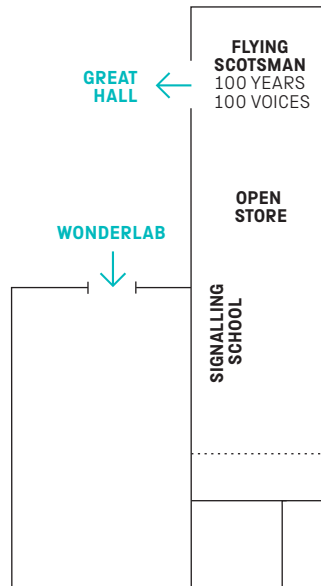
The Great Machine is made up of a collection of machines that work together to move the balls in interesting ways.
